## LETTER FROM OUR BUSINESS MANAGER



Dear San Antonio de Padua Family,

Thank you for your generous donations throughout the year, especially during the Easter season. We are truly blessed to have such giving parishioners, not only of your treasures, but of your time and talents as well. I'd like to share a brief update of how we're doing financially and where there are needs.

From July 1st last year until now, our parishioners have donated over 1.3 million dollars to the church. Included in that number is over \$200,000 in donations to our various ministries: Family Assistance, Respect Life, Hispanic Ministry, Religious Education, etc. Also, in that number is over \$60,000 in donations to Diocesan funded needs: Gifts to the Holy Land, the Religious Retirement Fund, Disaster Relief, etc. Other sources of income to the parish comes from donations for Weddings, Funerals and Baptisms, Income from our Cell Tower, Diocesan Rebates for reaching our PSA goal and Fiesta. We are a thriving parish!

Like most people notice in their own households, Expenses continue to rise. Again, from July 1st until now, our Expenses are almost 1.4 million dollars. Repairs, maintenance, and upkeep of the grounds are almost \$150,000 so far. Utilities are around \$75,000. Our Diocesan Assessment is over \$100,000. What's the point of this info?

We are very grateful for the gifts from our parishioners that make this church go! Certain Donations that are directed to specific areas of need are called Designated Funds and can only be used for those purposes. Gifts designated to specific ministries can only be used for those ministries. Gifts designated to specific purposes like Maintenance and Repairs can only be used for those purposes. Where there are shortfalls in those purposes or ministries, the balance is paid for through our general funds. Areas where we have our greatest shortfalls are Maintenance and Repairs, Religious Education and Youth Ministry.

Again, we are very grateful for your generosity, and I am not trying to "draw from the same well" for more... like I pointed out in a previous message. I am offering this information as "food for thought" as you assign your donations. Please reach out to me with any questions or concerns. Thank you again!

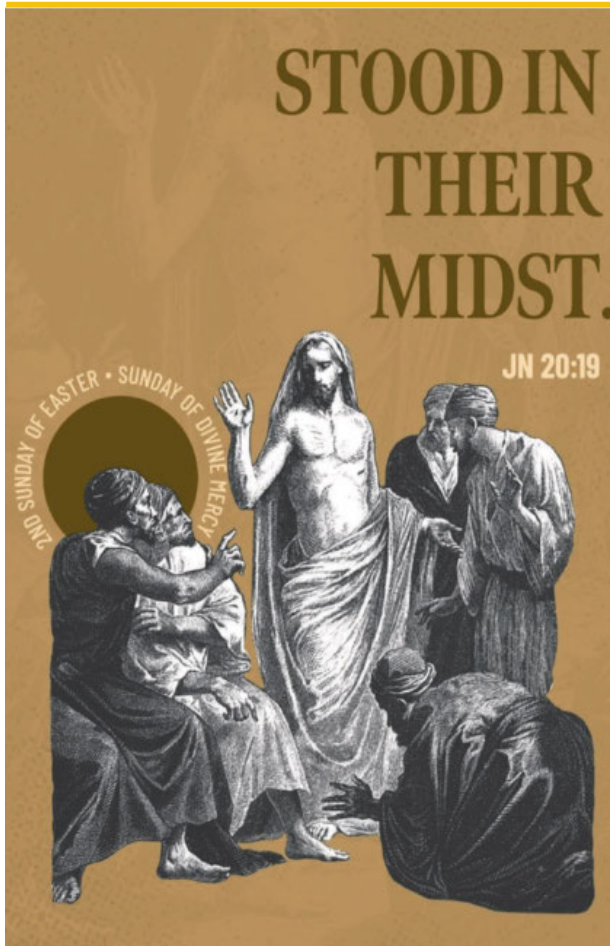

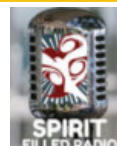
### WE ARE READY TO BLAST-OFF!

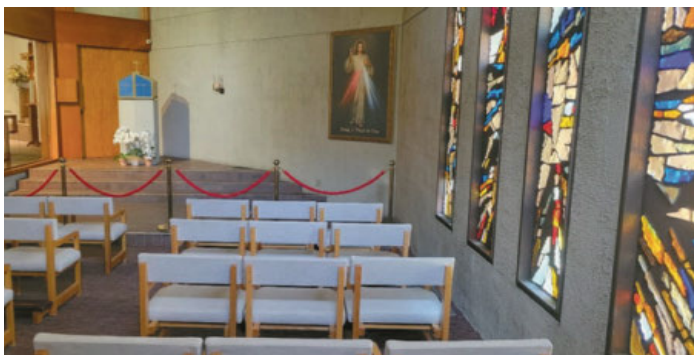

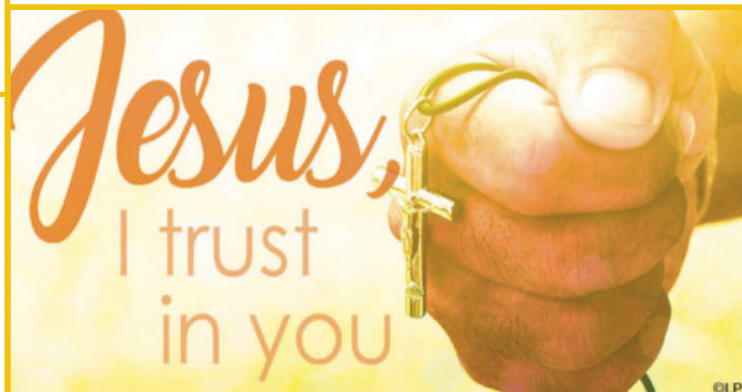
