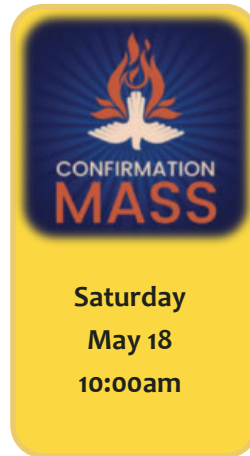

SACRISTANS URGENTLY NEEDED

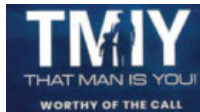


Being a Sacristan is a wonderful way to serve your church and an active way to participate in Mass.

The Sacristan prepares and oversees the Sacred Vessels required for Mass.

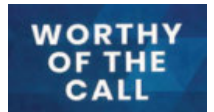
