### GOSPEL MEDITATION

The best way to understand the Eucharist is to recall God's long, careful teaching process beginning in the Old Testament. This week in Exodus 24, we learn the basic pattern. Moses reads the dictates of God's law to the people, who profess their allegiance to it. Then Moses takes representatives of Israel's twelve tribes and splashes the sacrificed blood of animals in two directions: on the altar and on the people. It's clear and serious business: clear, because the participants are entering a blood-bond with God Himself; serious, because the dead animals symbolize the life-and-death stakes at play.

Many centuries later, God uses the experience at Sinai to teach us something new. At the Last Supper, like a new Moses, Jesus proposes to "pour out" blood as a new covenant. It will land on the altar of the cross and the lips of his disciples. They have promised to be obedient to him who is God's law in flesh. This renews and elevates the breath-taking romance God wants with His people, unfolding from Sinai to this Supper. The Body and Blood of Christ is the sacrificial action whereby this covenant is strengthened.

How hopeful that, like us, the Israelites and the apostles repeatedly fail to live up to their promises and discover that the blood of the covenant continually renews and refreshes them. Today the blood of Christ faithfully flows, to unite and renew, moving us forward toward where our great teacher is taking us. This week, we should say a renewed "amen" to God who so carefully teaches us how to be one with Him in this new covenant.

## WELCOME DEACON TUAN DUC NGUYEN

I am deacon Paul-Marie Tuan Duc Nguyen. My wife is Tamminh Dang, my son Tuan-Viet Kevin Nguyen and my daughter Minh-Thu Tiffany Nguyen.

I was born in Hoi An, Viet Nam. I grew up in Hoi An, then in Da Nang, Hue, Qui Nhon, Da Lat until the loss of South Viet Nam (1975)

After having fled from my beloved VietNam in 1982, I lived in Montreal, Canada before moving to Orange, California, USA in 1986.

I was ordained permanent deacon on October 17, 2015, and Bishop Kevin Vann assigned me to St. Columban church.

In reflecting on my vocation, God first called me to be a priest in 1963. I was a seminarian from the “petit” Seminary to “grand” Seminary for 14 years and 6 years in parish internship.

The bishop of the diocese of Xuân Loc had tried 3 times to ask the local communist government to approve me to be ordained a priest, but they refused. I had to leave my calling to be a priest in 1984. In 2010, God called me again. He called me not to become a priest, but to be a permanent deacon. I said yes to Him. Bishop Timothy Fryer (then pastor of St. Boniface church) registered me for the diaconate formation. When God closes a door, somewhere He opens a window.

During a 3-day retreat before leaving the vocation of priesthood, I asked God, if I could not be a doctor of “soul”, then please let me be a doctor of “body”. It was amazing - God accepted my prayer. Today I am a doctor of Chiropractic in 31 years.

Saint Paul the Apostle is my Patron Saint and my role model of Evangelization. Mother Mary is also my Patron Saint and my role model of humility. I try to live the words Mother Mary told the Archangel Gabriel: “Here am I, the servant of the Lord.”

After 9 years of serving as deacon at St. Columban parish, Bishop Kevin Vann assigned me to San Antonio de Padua parish, Anaheim Hills.

Wherever I am, I will always be God’s unworthy servant.



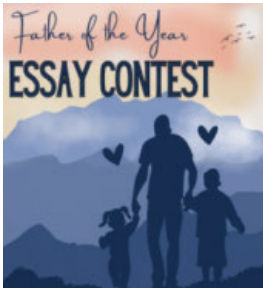

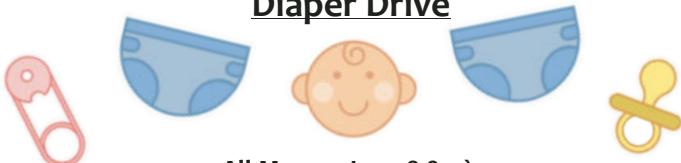

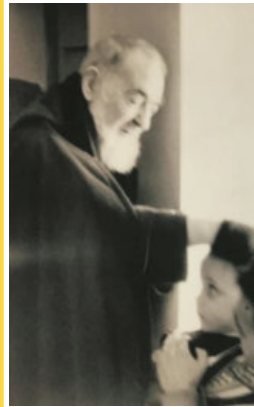

## SACRISTANS URGENTLY NEEDED

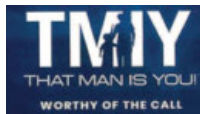


Being a Sacristan is a wonderful way to serve your church and an active way to participate in Mass.
