

MISSION APPEAL AT SAN ANTONIO CHURCH

On the weekend of August 3-4, 2024, Rev. Raja Selvam, a priest from India, who works in the Bishops' Council of Tamil Nadu, India as Director of Print Media Ministries will make mission appeal in our parish for their ministries. He is the editor-in-Chief of the fifty years old official Catholic Weekly named "Nam Vazhvu" (Our Life), which is being circulated in the Eighteen dioceses of Tamil Nadu, India. Established in January 1975, this magazine serves as a bastion of the Christian faith, disseminating the teachings of the Bible. With over 14,000 subscribers, including a few from Hindu and Muslim communities, "Nam Vazhvu" continues to touch hearts and transform lives. However, the challenges posed by the recent COVID-19 pandemic have strained their financial resources, making it difficult to sustain their ministry.



In addition, in the light of Vatican II, it trains young men and women in the field of social communication, particularly in print media ministry for their concerns; so that they can take the Gospel values to society through their skill of writing. One of their key aspirations is to nurture a new generation of writers and journalists who will carry forward the torch of truth and righteousness. Furthermore, they extend their outreach to rural and impoverished communities by providing access to their publications through parish and school libraries. Therefore, your contributions, no matter how small, have the power to make a profound impact on the lives of countless individuals – nurturing their faith, fostering inter-religious harmony, and encouraging young people as messengers of Christ. Together, let us be the hands and feet of Christ, bringing hope and salvation to all who seek it.






